





Hello! My name is Wendy Water. I am a drop of water.



There are many other drops like me in the world today. We cover about three-fourths of the earth's surface.




Did you know that it takes 115 gallons of water to grow enough wheat to make one loaf of bread?






Swimming, boating and fishing would not be fun without clean water.




The average urban household uses




170 gallons per day per person.

Ninety-seven percent of all the earth's water is in the oceans. This water is too salty to drink or grow crops.








